






### **CLIMATE INCENTIVES FOR MAINERS**

The Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) invests over \$350 billion to help fight the causes and impacts of climate change. Tax credits, rebates, and other incentives directly help individuals and businesses transition to cleaner technologies, from electric cars to heat pumps to rooftop solar panels.

Maine people are also eligible for many cost-saving rebates from Efficiency Maine. This booklet summarizes current incentives and tax credits available to Mainers through federal and state programs. 


